

Guard Against Online Identity Theft

PROTECT YOURSELF

- ⇒ Don't give out personal information via email
- ⇒ Update your virus protection software regularly
- ⇒ Use a firewall for extra protection
- ⇒ Do not download files or open email attachments from unknown sources
- ⇒ Before disposing of an old computer have the hard drive reformatted to "wipe" or overwrite your hard drive

IF YOUR IDENTITY IS COMPROMISED...

- ⇒ Place a fraud alert on your credit file by notifying the national credit bureaus
- ⇒ Contact all creditors and financial institutions and have all tampered accounts closed
- ⇒ Contact the Social Security Administration and advise them of your situation
- ⇒ Contact your local police department, as well as your local FBI field office and file a report
- ⇒ File a complaint with the Internet Crime Complaint Center(IC3) www.ic3.gov
